The Benefits ReCoERDO Brought to Personnel of CamboDHRRA

Him Noeun (Mr.), CamboDHRRA Secretary-General. He engaged with ReCoERDO project since early 2019 as national project coordinator under Farmer and Nature Net Association (FNN). In holding this position, he was responsible for overall projection implementation and management support included project proposal development, project progress review, reporting and communication with donors, BOD, consultants and relevant stakeholders. In addition, he worked closely with CamboDHRRA members and partners in preparing work plan, program development and organizing the events.

It's noted that FNN became ReCoERDO project implementer on May 2018. Since then, FNN that had Mr. Him Noeun as focal point, he mobilized agriculture-related institutions and people work together to improve agriculture production and market linkages by creating CamboDHRRA platform. As result, on 28 May 2020,



CamboDHRRA official registered at Ministry of Interior with 21 multi-sector institutions including 4 National Farmer Organizations, 12 National/International Non-Government Organizations and 5 private companies. Since that time, Mr. Him Noeun was recruited by Board of Directors of CamboDHRRA as Secretary-General.

Mr. Him Noeun said that "before ReCoERDO project, I was not too much involved in terms of carrying out my role in the organization development and management, Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) and Knowledge Management (KM), policy advocacy and research especially, how to engage with the government agencies, private sectors and stakeholders. When I involved ReCoERDO project, I had opportunities to participate in several capacity development and learning visits that organized by AsiaDHRRA and CamboDHRRA in the framework of ReCoERDO project. The main topics that I learned such as value chain and market empowerment, business plan, resource mobilization, constructive engagement, successor generation, gender development and mainstreaming, gender-sensitive monitoring and evaluation, MEAL and responsible agriculture investment (RAI). Since involved in the project until now, my knowledge and skills improved, I'm able to manage my roles in CamboDHRRA more effectively by building good partnership and relationship with members of CamboDHRRA, government official and also academia. In addition, some visibility materials were developed and widely disseminated, active involved in policy dialogues and research and I have confident in leading to organize workshops, fora and meetings. Furthermore, I have long-term vision and committed in leading to meet the goal of my organization.

Regarding to CamboDHRRA as organization, Noeun said that before ReCoERDO, CamboDHRRA did not exist the official structure and platform and very difficult to work with its members. Presently, because of ReCoERDO, CamboDHRRA was able to register officially and set up secretariat and staff, CamboDHRRA has set clear structure; functions and institutional policies; 5-year (2021-2025) strategic plan of CamboDHRRA developed; totally, 21 entities includes NFOs, NGOs and private companies who active involving in value chains and coops development became members of

CamboDHRRA; Capacity of staff of camboDHRRA members improved in terms of project cycle management, gender-sensitive M&E, agri-value chains and agricultural cooperative development; members of CamboDHRRA being involved in promoting the participation of youth in Responsible Agriculture Investment (RAI); through AsiaDHRRA platform/ReCoERDO, CamboDHRRA was able engaged and advocacy on Rural Development and Poverty Eradication at the regional level; CamboDHRRA has linked and strengthened relations with FAO country office; CamboDHRRA initiated to lead advocacy on "Responsible Agriculture Investment" especially for the youth at the national level through RAI mapping, case study, set up RAI core group and national workshop; Increasing of agri-business and contract farming partnership between FOs, NGOs and private companies; FOs/agricultural cooperative leaders are able to develop business plans, able to access loan from public bank (ARDB)/MFI, adopt new techniques on farm production, and improve market channels.

However, ReCoERDO should focus more on policy advocacy (national and region/ASEAN), market linkage (cross-country value chain), awareness on ASEAN Economic Community (AEC), access to finance for small scale farmers, promoting youth and women participation in agriculture investment, knowledge management and communication in agriculture and rural development, establishing of pool of experts and so forth.

Overall, all outcomes intended to achieve under ReCoERDO project were completely accomplished. The project also creates a historical legacy for us by establishing of CamboDHRRA as officially entity. CamboDHRRA has being continued the initiatives of ReCoERDO even though the project phase-out.

Last but not least, in the framework of its 5-year strategic plan (2021-2025), CamboDHRRA aims to achieve four strategic goals including: (i) Improved capacity of farmer organizations in technical, business, and organizational development, (ii) Increased market access and capital investment for farmer organizations, (iii) Improved enabling environment for effective and profitable farmers' businesses and (iv) Increased capacity of CamboDHRRA to effectively serve its members, especially farmer organizations.
